#### I. **CALL TO ORDER**

Board Chair, Luke Muszkiewicz, called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

#### **REVIEW OF AGENDA** II.

#### **REVIEW OF MINUTES** IV.

Minutes from the June 08, 2021, Executive Committee meeting were reviewed. No changes were made.

#### ٧. **REVIEW OF 8.10.21 BOARD MEETING AGENDA**

The committee reviewed the agenda for the 8.10.21 board meeting. It was discussed that the Superintendent's report would be moved to item II on the agenda. Mr. Weltz said he would spend some time on recognition and his first 30 days as Superintendent.

The committee then discussed that the board would be certifying the trustees' financial summary for elementary and high school and would be adopting the final budget for elementary and high school for the fiscal year of 2021-22.

It was then discussed that the board would be reviewing Policy 1905 Student, Staff, and Community Health and Safety Needs. The revisions being recommended are noted below:

If the number of active COVID-19 cases in the county increases to the point of being considered a "substantial" or "high" rate of transmission as defined by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the Board of Trustees authorizes the Superintendent to implement a requirement for face coverings to be worn in all Elementary District PreK-8 schools and PreK-8 programs. The Superintendent may also <u>consult with local health experts to in</u>clude but not be limited to: St. Peter's Health, Lewis and Clark Public Health and other local health providers.

In the event it is determined face coverings are required, the Superintendent shall announce the face covering requirement to students, parents, staff, and visitors for the immediate successive school week by 3:00 pm on Friday of the previous week. If the Superintendent determines masks are required, signs will be installed to inform students, parents, staff, and visitors of mask requirements while present in the identified District buildings.

All points of entry to any school building or facility open to the public shall have a clearly visible sign posted stating whether masks are required or recommended.

Lastly, it was noted that in the agenda the Student Representative Report was left out of Section C under reports, and that would be included in the board meeting.
